RELEASE, WAIVER, AND AGREEMENT OF INDEMNITY – PREMISES INFORMATION FILE

The undersigned has requested permission of the City of Mountain View to receive premises information for their property for the purpose of situational awareness and access for Fire Department and Police Department emergency response. The undersigned has been fully informed of the risk associated with providing premises information, including that damage to property may still occur if field personnel do not receive the information, the information is inaccurate or outdated, the information is deleted from the computer-aided dispatch (CAD) system, or access for any other reason requires "forcible entry" or property damage.

The intention of the City of Mountain View's premises information program is to provide first responder personnel with property information that may aid with access to the property, situational awareness, or further assistance with the rescue of occupants. Information may include, but not be limited to, lockbox information, hidden key locations, gate code information, or occupant information, such as presence and location of a nonambulatory person. The undersigned hereby expressly assumes the risk of injury or damage that may result if the accurate premises information is not received or utilized by first responder personnel and releases and waives all claims now existing or hereafter arising, whether known or unknown, for any injury or damage to person or property arising out of, relating to, or occurring during the course of using such premises information, and agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Mountain View and the City's officers, agents, and employees from any and all such claims.

The undersigned further agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Mountain View and the City's officers, agents, and employees from any claims of injury or damage to person or property, which third parties may have or assert, whether now existing or hereafter arising, as a result, in whole or in part, of negligent, willful, or intentional acts or admission of the undersigned.

The undersigned hereby waives the provisions of Section 1542 of the California Civil Code, which provides: "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known to him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor."
