

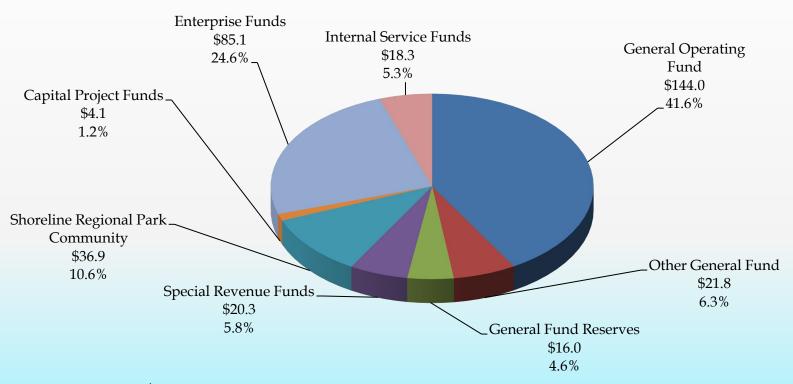
Adoption of Fiscal Year 2020-21 Budgets Public Hearing

JUNE 23, 2020

Budget Overview

- Budget development and adoption is 7 month process
- FY 2020-21 Proposed Budget is structurally balanced
- Status quo with existing service levels
- Budget updates will be presented to Council every quarter
- Budget deficit of \$100k forecasted to start in FY 2021-22. Could grow to \$2-4M depending on economic effects of shelter in place order.
- Much uncertainty still ahead

Next Steps

- Council Subcommittee on Race, Equity and Inclusion to engage the community in meaningful dialogue and hear from community leaders and stakeholders
- Review of policing polices for alignment with best practice recommendations, including those advocated by the 8 Can't Wait campaign, Campaign Zero, and the California Attorney General
- Human Relations Commission Civility Roundtable on unconscious bias and other assistance in community convening
- Explore alternative service delivery models, working with regional agencies and community partners, for community needs such as mental health, substance abuse and homelessness
- Report back to Council in the Fall on next steps.





Motion #1

- 3. Adopt a Resolution Amending the City of Mountain View Master Fee Schedule, to be read in title only, further reading waived.





Motion #1 (continued)

City of Mountain View Actions:

- 4. Commit \$1,635,000 of Park Land Dedication funds to the adopted Fiscal Year 2020-21 Capital Projects, including amendments to existing projects.
- 5. Adopt a Resolution Authorizing the City Manager or Her Designee to Amend the Classification and Salary Plans for Regular and Hourly Employees for Fiscal Year 2020-21, to be read in title only, further reading waived.
