DANCE PERMIT CONDITIONS (NONANNUAL)

Any dance permit issued by the Police Chief is subject to the conditions set forth below. Pursuant to Mountain View City Code Section 26.28, these conditions are necessary to safeguard the public health, morals, safety, and welfare.

NOISE:

- 1. The applicant for a dance permit will limit noise-generating activities (i.e., live entertainment or amplified sound) to interior areas and maintain all doors and windows in a fully closed condition during the hours of operation authorized by a dance permit.
- 2. Exterior noise levels shall not exceed sixty-five (65) decibels when measured at the property line.
- 3. Decibel level of amplification shall be subject to reduction following the request of any Police Officer.

SECURITY:

Security guards will perform, at a minimum, the following duties:

- a Patrol the parking lot(s) during the hours of the dance;
- b. Walk through interior areas to ensure that the doors and windows remain closed during noise-generating activities;
- c. Ensure alcoholic beverages are not removed from, or consumed outside, the facility; and
- d. Ensure noise levels do not exceed maximum decibel levels.

PERMIT APPROVAL NOTIFICATION:

The Police Department will verify that an appropriate number of security guards hired from a security company licensed to do business in Mountain View has been hired for the applicant's dance event. Upon verification and prior to the dance event, the applicant will be notified by telephone to obtain a dance permit from the Police Department.

I have fully read, understand, and agree to the conditions of the dance permit. I understand that, in addition to the foregoing conditions, the dance permit is subject to the dance regulations set forth in Mountain View City Code Chapter 26, Article III, Sections 26.24 through 26.34. I further understand that the dance permit may be revoked or suspended for any of the reasons stated in Mountain View City Code Section 26.30, including, but not limited to, failure to comply with any of the conditions of the dance permit.
