

## CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW WATER CREDIT APPLICATION

Water credits are authorized through Mountain View City Code Section 35.27.1 and are based on a three-tiered structure of water usage rates. The City Code authorizes water credits in cases where a leak results in water use at the third-tier water rate (above the customer's historical use). This code allows water charged at the third-tier rate to be reduced to the second-tier rate. Providing a credit in this way allows the City to recover costs of the water used, while at the same time offering some relief to customers who have had the misfortune of a water leak that has significantly increased their utility bill. Customers are eligible for a water credit on one billing period every three years. To see if you qualify, please look at your most recent water bill to confirm you have third-tier water use. Accounts without third-tier water use are not eligible for water credits.

## Applictions should be submitted after your leak has been fixed and you have received the bill covering your leak period.
