- 2,000 free lawn tickets are available to Mountain View residents, courtesy of Shoreline Amphitheatre and the City of Mountain View. There is a limit of 4 tickets per household.
- Mountain View residents may also purchase discounted lawn and upper reserved tickets for \$15 each (limit of 8 tickets per household). Discounted tickets are also courtesy of Shoreline Amphitheatre and the City of Mountain View and can be purchased up to and including the day of the event.
- Parking lots open at 4pm, and doors open at 5pm with games and activities for family fun.
 An additional \$25 parking fee will be collected the night of the event.
- *To obtain free or discounted tickets: PRINT AND BRING THIS COUPON, proof of residency (a driver's license AND current utility bill with a Mountain View address) to the Shoreline Amphitheatre box office.
- The Shoreline Amphitheatre box office is open Wednesdays and Saturdays, 10am to 2pm, and on event days starting at 12pm.
