A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW
CALLING A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE (3)
MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO AUTHORIZE
THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS TO CONTRACT FOR ELECTION SERVICES,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO CONTRACT WITH THE COUNTY OF SANTA CLARA PERTAINING
TO SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED BY THE COUNTY IN CONNECTION WITH THE GENERAL
MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2022, AND RELATED ACTIONS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mountain View hereby calls a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, for the purpose of electing three (3) members of the City Council for a four-year term pursuant to the City of Mountain View Charter, §§401 and 500; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide election to be held on the same date; that within the City, the precincts, vote centers, and election officers of the two (2) elections be the same; that the Registrar of Voters of the County of Santa Clara canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election; and that the election be held in all respects as if it were only one (1) election;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mountain View has requested the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Clara to order the General Municipal Election to be consolidated with the Statewide election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, pursuant to and in the manner described in the California Elections Code, §§10403 and 10418; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk of the City of Mountain View has recommended that the City contract with the County of Santa Clara to have the Registrar of Voters perform certain services in connection with the General Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council that the City contract with the County to have the Registrar of Voters perform certain services for said General Municipal Election as authorized by California Elections Code §10002;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Mountain View as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Call of Election</u>. A General Municipal Election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of Mountain View on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, at which election there shall be an election of Councilmembers.

- <u>Section 2</u>. <u>Officers to Be Elected</u>. The officers to be elected at said General Municipal Election shall be three (3) Councilmembers, at-large, each for a term of four (4) years.
- <u>Section 3.</u> <u>Vote Centers Open.</u> Vote centers for said election shall be open at 7:00 a.m. on the day of said election and shall remain open continuously from said time until 8:00 p.m. of the same day, when said vote centers shall be closed, except as provided in California Elections Code §14401.
- <u>Section 4</u>. <u>Publication</u>. The City Clerk of the City of Mountain View is hereby ordered and directed to cause the notice of said election to be published in accordance with the provisions of the California Elections Code. The notice of the General Municipal Election provided for herein shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Mountain View.
- Section 5. Consolidation with Statewide Election. Pursuant to the requirements of California Elections Code §10403, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Clara is hereby requested to order the General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, and to consolidate the election with any other Statewide elections, which may be called for the same date. The consolidated election will be held and conducted in the manner prescribed by California Elections Code §10418. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Clara is further requested to order the County Registrar of Voters to: (1) prepare the City's election materials and take all other necessary actions for the holding of the consolidated election; and (2) provide Vote by Mail (VBM) ballot to voters for said election for use of the qualified electors of the City of Mountain View who are entitled thereto, in the manner provided by law.
- <u>Section 6</u>. <u>Canvassing</u>. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Clara is hereby further authorized and requested to canvass or cause to be canvassed, as provided by law, returns of said General Municipal Election and to certify such canvass of the votes cast for the City Council of the City of Mountain View.
- <u>Section 7.</u> Agreement with the County. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the County of Santa Clara for the performance of certain election services for the City by the County Registrar of Voters pertaining to the conduct of said General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, and for the reimbursement of the County in full for the services performed pursuant to California Elections Code §§ 10002 and 10520.
- <u>Section 8</u>. <u>Services to be Performed</u>. The County Registrar of Voters shall perform the following services for the City:
 - 1. Consolidating precincts and arranging for vote centers and election officers.
 - 2. Prepare election materials, including official and sample ballots.
 - 3. Addressing and mailing sample ballots.

- 4. Handling applications for and mailing vote-by-mail ballots.
- 5. Bagging and labeling of precinct supplies.
- 6. Supervising computerized return of ballots cast.
- 7. Providing general assistance for the conduct of said election.
- 8. Canvassing the election returns and certifying the results to the City Clerk.

<u>Section 9</u>. <u>Tie Vote</u>. Ties among candidates for any office shall be settled by the drawing of lots pursuant to Mountain View City Charter §500.

<u>Section 10</u>. <u>Certification</u>. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Mountain View as follows:

- 1. The Statement of Qualifications for each candidate in the General Municipal Election to be held Tuesday, November 8, 2022, shall not exceed 200 words.
- 2. As provided by Chapter 2, Article XII, Division 3, Section 2.151 of the Mountain View City Code, candidates who file a statement of acceptance of the Voluntary Expenditure Limit (VEL) and pay the first \$500 toward the cost of publishing the candidate's Statement of Qualifications at the time nomination papers are filed are eligible to receive a contribution towards the cost of publishing their Statement of Qualifications from the City in an amount up to the remaining balance (full amount minus \$500) of the publishing costs, subject to fund availability.
- 3. No other candidate materials will be permitted in the sample ballot for said General Municipal Election to be held Tuesday, November 8, 2022.
- 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW
RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022,
DECLARING THE RESULT, AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Mountain View, California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, as required by law to elect three members to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form, and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and votes were cast, received, and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form, and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, and the results are received, attached, and made a part hereof as Exhibit A; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of Mountain View does resolve, declare, determine and order as follows:

- 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the City of Mountain View was 24,595.
- 2. That the names of the persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council are as follows:

- 3. That the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates were as listed in Exhibit A.
- 4. That the City Council does declare and determine that Ellen Kamei, Alison Hicks, and Lucas Ramirez were elected as Members of the City Council for the full term of four years.

- 5. - 6. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the Office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected in accordance with Mountain View Charter Section 500.
