

## NOTICE OF RECOLOGY EXCLUSIVE HAULING AGREEMENT

Recology Mountain View is the City's exclusive hauler for collection of the community's trash, recycling and yard trimmings, including debris box services for construction and demolition materials.

If your project uses a debris box hauler, it must be Recology. No other debris box haulers may be used for recycling or disposal.



Violation. Using a hauler for recycling or disposal other than Recology violates City Code (16.13, 16.17). If your project uses a debris box, you must use Recology. A "Stop Use Notice" may be placed on the box and a citation issued to the illegal hauler and the property owner or contractor.

**Exceptions.** No hauler other than Recology may provide debris box service unless:

- (1) The construction and demolition debris is generated by a state-licensed contractor and hauled by said contractor as an incidental part of total services (e.g., roofer, landscaper). Contractors shall transport such materials in their own containers or vehicles owned or leased and driven by its employees. Contractor shall not use any subcontractor or thirdparty hauler unless it meets the conditions in (2) below.
- (2) If you are selling or donating **source-separated recyclables** (e.g., a box of metal or box of wood). The recycling hauler must provide the service at no charge and have both a nonexclusive City collection agreement and a Mountain View Business License.

All debris boxes containing mixed materials are sorted for recycling at Zanker Material Processing Facility. Boxes for source-separated recyclables (wood, drywall, cardboard, etc.) or yard trimmings are available at a discounted rate.

## Recology must place the debris box on the private property (e.g., in a driveway).

To request an exception that would allow Recology to put a debris box on the public street, you must apply for and obtain an approved encroachment permit. To apply, contact the Public Works Department's Land Development Section at 650-903-6311 or LandDev.App@MountainView.gov. No other debris boxes may be placed in the street.
