### MIXED RECYCLING





### **NO FOOD OR LIQUID**

All recyclables must be clean and dry. Empty all containers and scrape out food.



#### **NO SINGLE-USE PLASTICS**

Only plastic bottles, tubs, jugs and jars can be recycled. All other plastics go in the trash.



#### **NO BLACK BAGS**

Place recyclables loose in the bin or bag recyclables in clear, transparent plastic bags.

### CARDBOARD RECYCLING





### **NO UNFLATTENED BOXES**

Save space in your bin by removing packaging and flattening all boxes.



### **NO PLASTIC PACKAGING**

Remove bubble wrap, Styrofoam™, or other plastic. These plastics go in the trash.



### **DO NOT BAG**

Place flattened cardboard loose in the bin. Do not use plastic bags.

### **COMPOST**





### **NO LIQUIDS**

Drain liquids (e.g., broth) before composting food.



### **NO PLASTIC, METAL, OR GLASS**

Remove all non-paper packaging. Single-use plastics go in the trash.



#### **NO BLACK BAGS**

Bag food scraps in paper bags, compostable bags, or in clear, transparent plastic bags.
