NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN a public hearing has been scheduled to discuss CDBG and HOME program updates and recommendations for the Fiscal Year 2024-25 Annual Action Plan process.

The City's Fiscal Year 2020-25 Consolidated Plan outlines six priority goals and how federal grants such as Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) will be used to achieve these goals. Annual Action plans are developed each year to implement the Five-Year Consolidated Plan and include a summary of the activities and projects that will be funded to further the priority goals. These goals are:

- Increase affordable housing for lower-income and special-needs households.
- Establish and support programs to prevent and end homelessness.
- Support activities that promote safety, security, wellness, and well-being for lower-income households and special-needs populations, such as seniors, abused and neglected youth, and the disabled.
- Support programs and activities that strengthen and enhance neighborhoods.
- Promote fair housing opportunities.
- Promote economic resiliency and improve workforce development and skills training.
