SR-82 – PAVEMENT REHABILITATION AND ADA IMPROVEMENTS



DESCRIPTION:

This project proposes to cold plane and overlay existing AC pavement, repair localized AC pavement, and repair localized failed PCC pavement along SR 82 from 0.7 mile of SR-237 to Sand Hill Road. This pavement conservation project also proposes to upgrade the existing non-standard ADA curb ramps with new ADA curb ramps in compliance with the American Disability Act (ADA) and complete street elements.



PURPOSE & NEED:

PURPOSE: The purpose of this project is to preserve and extend the life of existing pavement and improve ride quality and to upgrade existing pedestrian facilities to comply with current ADA standards and to improve safety, access, and mobility for pedestrians at signalized intersections on the State Highway System.

NEED: The project is initiated to meet the requirements of Capital Preventive Maintenance (CAPM) program to improve ride quality, to comply with current ADA standard, and to improve safety, access, and mobility of pedestrians and bike at these locations.

PROJECT SCOPE:

- Cold plane and overlay Asphalt Concrete (AC) pavement with Rubberized Asphalt Concrete (RAC)
- Repair localized failed concrete pavement.
- Upgrade the existing curb ramps to new ADA compliant curb ramps
- Upgrade several signal poles and push button for crosswalk to APS (Accessible Pedestrian Signal) and higher visibility crosswalk markings
- Install three new Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon systems of State Route 82 and Bonita Ave, Crestview Dr, and Pettis Ave
- Install approximately six miles of either Class II or Class IV bicycle lanes
- Upgrade pavement, pedestrian, and bicycle crossing delineations
