

SR-82/EL CAMINO REAL

PAVEMENT REHABILITATION AND ADA IMPROVEMENTS



Caltrans is scheduled to begin Pavement and ADA improvements on State Route 82 El Camino Real, between south of State Route-237, Mountain View to Sand Hill Road, Menlo Park/Palo Alto. This pavement rehabilitation project also proposes to upgrade the existing non-standard ADA curb ramps with new ADA curb ramps in compliance with the American Disability Act (ADA) and Complete Street elements. All work is weather and conditions dependent.

WHY THE WORK IS NEEDED?

The purpose of this project is to preserve and extend the life of existing pavement and improve ride quality and to upgrade existing pedestrian facilities to comply with current ADA Standards and to improve safety, access and mobility for pedestrians at signalized intersections on the State Highway System.

NEED: The project is initiated to meet the requirements of Capital Preventive Maintenance (CAPM) program to improve ride quality, to comply with current ADA standard, and to improve safety, access, and mobility of pedestrians and bike at these locations.

ADDITIONAL WORK THAT IS HAPPENING:

- · Cold plane and overlay AC pavement,
- Repair localized failed AC and PCC pavement.
- Upgrade the existing curb ramps to new ADA compliant curb ramps.
- Install APS (Accessible Pedestrian Signal) and high visibility crosswalk markings
- Install 3 new Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon systems
- Install approximately 6 miles of either type II or type IV bike lanes
- Upgrade pavement delineations per MUTCD.

PROJECT IS SCHEDULED TO BE COMPLETE BY FALL OF 2025
