## for Income-qualified Residents of Mountain View

The City of Mountain View, in partnership with Acterra, is excited to introduce the E-Bike Voucher Program! This initiative provides eligible low to moderate income Mountain View residents with vouchers to help them purchase electric bikes from designated vendors. By lowering barriers to e-bike adoption, we aim to enhance the well-being of both our community and the environment. The Program is accepting applications through April 28th.

Check eligibility at mountainview.gov/
e-bikes



Buy your electric bike.



Fill out the online application.



Complete the postapplication survey in your inbox.



Receive a voucher once your eligibility is confirmed.



Enjoy your clean and safe ride.



## **Eligibility Criteria for Application**

- 1. Residents of Mountain View with valid proof of residence.
- 2. Mountain View residents lacking fixed housing (must provide a letter from a local homeless shelter or nonprofit serving Mountain View).
